

- > Sets a specific course of action for a community
- Serves as a basis for future decisions for a community
- Officially adopted by a municipality




TRADITIONAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN >

- > Static document
- Implementation "To Do" Lists that do not reflect community values, principles, and priorities
- > Fails to determine what really is occurring or too technical
- Committee relegated to read and respond



IMPLEMENTABLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN >

- > Focuses on specific topics that are relevant to the community
- > Builds implementation through plan development
- > Plan ownership by the community
- > Plan content focuses on telling the community story


